Singing for Syrians is a nationwide campaign from the Hands Up Foundation encouraging people across the UK to hold or attend music events to raise funds and awareness for some of Syria's most vulnerable.

This year, among other projects, we are supporting three that we are particularly proud of:

Funding salaries at a Primary Health Clinic in southern rural Aleppo

Providing vital health services to the local community including vaccinations, childhood immunisations, and psycho-social services.

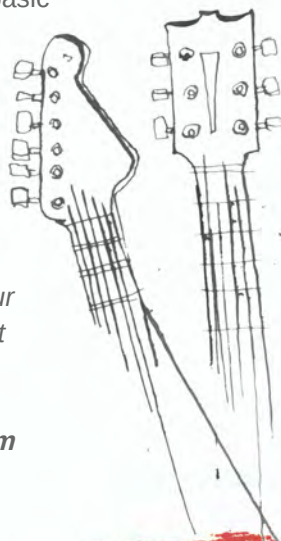
A Prosthetic Limb Clinic run by the NSPPL in Bab al-Hawa

Funding pays for staff salaries, materials, rent and fuel as well as patient treatment. A limb above the knee costs around £500, and this programme is designed to get people back to work or simply to restore dignity.

Education for 300 children in Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

This project aims to provide Syrian refugee children with basic literary and numeracy skills required for formal education, providing hope for a better life and a brighter future.

The project also provides livelihoods for teachers and support staff, employed from the local refugee community.
